Dear Olympia,

I am writing to inform you that, after a considerable research on the different factors involved in your request to have your name changed on your records in Cal Poly Pomona, the Registrar's Office has determined that it is unable to grant your request without your presentation of a social security card that bears your new name. Here are the reasons for not being able to grant your request:

- You are a recipient of a Federal student loan and your social security number and current student name is reported to the Federal government.
- You are a student assistant in the University and therefore receive taxable income. Your income is reported to the Internal Revenue Service under your social security name and current student name.

Your records in the University will therefore remain as Jared Clifford Tveter. You are strongly encouraged to file a change of name request as soon as you are able to present either a new drivers license or social security card bearing your new name of Olympia Tveter.
